

Release of QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook Version 4.0

Purpose

To inform schools of the release of the *QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook v4.0*, which outlines the policies and procedures schools need to follow as they support students to work towards their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) or Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA).

Background

Each year, the QCAA reviews and updates the *QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook* to ensure it accurately reflects the necessary information for schools. Changes are approved by the QCAA Board before the updated handbook is released.

The *QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook v4.0* replaces Version 3.0, and is available online at www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/senior/certificates-and-qualifications/qce-qcia-handbook. A PDF version and change log summarising the key changes in each section are available via the Noticeboard in the QCAA Portal.

The handbook has been updated to reflect:

- feedback received from Queensland schools and stakeholders during 2022, particularly from principal's delegates forums in Term 3
- frequently asked questions from schools and other stakeholders
- the refinement and further development of systems and processes since the implementation of the QCE system in 2019.

What you need to do

Schools should begin using the *QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook v4.0* as soon as possible. They should ensure all staff are aware of the handbook so they can start referring to it.

Schools should review their policies and procedures and update them to align with the *QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook v4.0*.
