2023 EA marker training schedule now available

Purpose

To notify teachers, schools and other eligible applicants that the schedule for external assessment marker training is now available.

Background

External assessment subject marking operations, including script selection and subject-specific training dates, are determined by the 2023 external assessment timetable, the number of student responses and the estimated time needed to mark a student response.

Information

The 2023 EA marker training schedule for General and General (Extension) subjects is now available at www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/downloads/senior/snr_ea_markers_training_schedule.pdf.

The schedule will be updated in Term 3 to include training dates for language Senior External Examination (SEE) marking.

Applicants should note that in some instances there is a planned delay between the date of assessment and the commencement of marker training, which is reflected in the EA marker training schedule.
