Applications open for 2024 NAPLAN writing test markers

Purpose

- To notify teachers, schools and other eligible applicants that the QCAA is seeking applications to mark the National Assessment Program — Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) writing tests in 2024.
- To remind 2023 NAPLAN markers to reapply as QCAA marker, group leader and professional leader roles are annual appointments.

Background

The QCAA employs and trains registered and non-practising or retired Queensland teachers to mark student responses to the NAPLAN writing tests using an online marking platform. The QCAA provides support and training for new and returning markers.

Information

The QCAA is seeking applications for the following NAPLAN marking roles:

- markers
- group leaders
- professional leaders.

Benefits of becoming a NAPLAN marker

NAPLAN markers can:

- gain insight into how students respond to an 'on demand' writing task
- increase their understanding about using a rubric to make judgments about student work
- gain CPD points for Queensland College of Teachers registration renewal
- share expertise with their school and colleagues
- work flexible hours from home
- · earn extra income for training and marking.





NAPLAN professional leaders and group leaders can:

- · earn a higher hourly rate
- receive training in marker monitoring and quality assurance measures
- gain experience in operational management, mentoring, leadership and training of markers and group leaders
- have opportunities to collaborate with other group leaders, professional leaders and managers
 of marking as well as provide feedback and contribute ideas to improve marking processes.

Important dates

- Applications are open now and close on 10 November 2023. Apply early as there are limited marker positions available.
- First round offers will be sent out during October and November 2023. Second round offers will be sent out from January to early February 2024.
- The marking operation will run from mid March for approximately four weeks or until all student scripts are marked.

What you need to do

- Encourage teachers and other eligible applicants to apply.
- Remind 2023 markers to reapply as marking is an annual appointment.
