Administering the ancillary phase of the common internal assessment in 2025

Purpose

To inform senior secondary schools about the QCAA's processes and procedures to support schools administer the ancillary phase of the common internal assessment (CIA) for Essential English or Essential Mathematics.

Background

A student's exit result in Essential English or Essential Mathematics is based on their achievement in four internal assessments across Units 3 and 4. Schools develop three of these assessments. The fourth assessment — the CIA — is developed by the QCAA and marked by schools.

For most schools, the CIA is delivered in two phases in Term 2, 2025. The ancillary phase is delivered in Term 3, 2025 for alternative learning centres that are registered for the ancillary phase, and schools that have notified the QCAA that they require a comparable assessment. Different versions of the CIA are used in each phase. Schools can check their selected CIA phase in the Student Management application (app) in the QCAA Portal.

The QCAA website and the *Common Internal Assessment: Guidelines for Administration* (GFA) provide further contextual information about the CIA.

Information

Assessment materials

The ancillary phase of the CIA runs from **Monday 11 August to Friday 12 September**. Schools should not distribute materials to students before Monday 11 August and only do so in accordance with the guidelines for managing the assessment (see GFA).

Flexible learning centres or alternative learning centres that are registered for the ancillary phase, and schools that have notified the QCAA that they require a comparable assessment, will receive the assessment materials on **Tuesday 5 August between 9am and 1pm**. A courier will deliver these secure materials to a school's administration office/reception only.

On the day the materials arrive, schools must check they have received the required quantity of materials for each subject. Schools will need to acknowledge receipt of materials and notify the QCAA if more are required. The QCAA will email instructions regarding the process.





If the materials do not arrive at your school on the scheduled delivery date, please notify the QCAA on 1300 239 227.

If your school is unable to accept delivery on the scheduled date and intends to proceed with the ancillary phase of the CIA, please email CIA@qcaa.qld.edu.au, at least one week prior to the scheduled date, to determine an alternative delivery method.

Schools will receive:

Essential English

- a set number of teacher packs. Schools can make additional copies if needed. Teacher packs
 include copies of the CIA question and response book, stimulus book, and the marking guide.
 These are to be used for teacher preparation and removes the need to open any
 shrink-wrapped materials until the day of assessment.
- shrink-wrapped bundle/s of assessment materials that include/s the CIA question and response book, stimulus book and the marking guide. These must be kept secure. Schools must not give students access to assessment materials prior to the start of the phase.
- bundle/s of seen stimulus to be distributed to students three weeks prior to the CIA session.

Essential Mathematics

- a set number of teacher packs. Schools can make additional copies if needed. Teacher packs
 include copies of the CIA question and response book, formula book and the marking guide.
 These are to be used for teacher preparation and to remove the need to open any
 shrink-wrapped materials until the day of assessment.
- shrink-wrapped bundle/s of assessment materials that include/s the CIA question and response book, formula book and the marking guide. These must be kept secure.

Alternative formats

Schools will receive:

- individually named assessment packs for students who require an alternative print format
- alternative format digital files for students with approved use of assistive technology on
 Tuesday 5 August. These documents will be available via the General files tab in the
 fileShare app on the same day as the scheduled delivery date. Note: Further instructions for
 downloading files can be found in the fileShare quick step quide available within the app.

Schools of Distance Education should notify the QCAA if they require digital format by **Tuesday 29 July** by contacting the External Assessment Operations Unit on 1300 239 227 or CIA@qcaa.qld.edu.au. These versions will be available to these schools in the fileShare app on **Tuesday 5 August**. **Note**: These digital files are non-interactive and designed to be printed. They are different to interactive files made available to students with approved use of computers/assistive technology.

Administration and security

The GFA is the key reference document for schools implementing a CIA. An electronic version of the GFA is available on the Noticeboard app in the QCAA Portal.

What you need to do

Schools must:

- check if they have registered any student to receive a comparable assessment for the CIA for Essential English or Essential Mathematics by recording 'comparable assessment' for IA2 for the subject (using the AARA app in the QCAA Portal)
- ensure relevant staff are registered to use, and know how to use, the fileShare app
- store all CIA materials securely, including unused materials (even if unable to complete the assessment)
- contact the External Assessment Operations Unit if materials do not arrive on Tuesday 5
 August
