Applications open for NAPLAN markers

Purpose

This memo serves to:

- notify teachers, schools and other eligible applicants that the QCAA is seeking applications to mark the NAPLAN writing tests in 2026.
- encourage experienced NAPLAN markers who have not been contacted directly to apply, as QCAA professional leader, group leader and marker roles are annual appointments.

Background

The QCAA employs and trains practising or registered non-practising Queensland teachers, including supply and retired teachers, to mark student responses for the NAPLAN writing tests using an online marking platform.

QCAA professional leader, group leader and marker roles are appointed annually and not in perpetuity.

Information

The QCAA is seeking applications for these NAPLAN marking roles:

- markers
- group leaders
- · professional leaders.

For NAPLAN 2026, selected experienced NAPLAN markers have been invited to confirm their availability for the marking operation.

New markers, and experienced markers who have not received a separate invitation, are encouraged to apply through the vacancy.

- The marking operation commences on Saturday 21 March 2026, and continues until all student responses have been marked.
