

Confirmation submission information for 2025 General senior syllabuses

Purpose

To advise schools that the *Confirmation submission information* has been updated to align with the 2025 General senior syllabuses.

Information

Confirmation is an annual quality assurance process for General and General (Extension) subjects. (For more information about confirmation, see the [QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook v7.0, Section 9.6.](#))

The *Confirmation submission information* provides general guidance and subject-specific information to support the confirmation process, including information about the file types and file sizes suitable for submitting via the Confirmation application (app) in the [QCAA Portal](#).

The *Confirmation submission information* has been updated with submission information relating to the 2025 General senior syllabuses and is now available on the [QCAA website](#) (see relevant senior syllabus > Resources > Quality assurance) and in the [QCAA Portal](#) via the Syllabuses app (see Resources > Quality assurance) and Noticeboard app (see Internal Assessment and Certification resources for schools).

Schools should use the *Confirmation submission information* to ensure they provide the required materials (see [QCE and QCIA policy and procedures handbook v7.0, Section 9.6.](#)).

- teachers know about and access the updated [Confirmation submission information](#)
- their strategies for evidence collection aligns with the subject-specific confirmation submission information for each General and General (Extension) syllabus.
