## Release of subject reports: endorsement 2026

### Purpose

To advise teachers and schools that the 2026 *Subject report: Endorsement* for each General, General (Extension) and Applied (Essential) subject is now available.

### Information

Annual subject reports provide an overview of the year's teaching, learning and assessment cycle for each subject.

In 2026, subject reports will be released with timely, targeted information and advice about endorsement, confirmation and external assessment.

The *Subject report: Endorsement* is the first mid-year release report, which will support schools as they develop all three internal assessment instruments for submission at Endorsement event 1 in August and Endorsement event 2 in February of each year.

The report:

- presents analysis of data and information from the endorsement process, including the application of syllabus objectives through assessment design
- provides advice from the chief endorser in consultation with QCAA subject experts
- identifies effective practices in the design of valid, accessible assessments
- identifies practices to strengthen and recommendations to enhance assessment design.
