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## **Section 1. Create your PowerPoint**

### ***Setting the scene***

Recently, you and your classmates went on a school camp. During the camp, you recorded your camp experiences by:

- writing diary entries about camp experiences (including your duties)
- drawing pictures and taking photos of the camp environment (including flora and fauna)
- taking photographs of you, your classmates and activities you participated in.

### ***What you need to do***

Using your records of your camp, create and present to the class a PowerPoint slide show about your favourite camp experiences.

Your PowerPoint slide show must:

- be written in Italian
- include photographs and/or pictures
- be presented to the class using spoken Italian
- show use of the present tense form of verbs
- be 3 minutes in length (using at least six slides).

### ***Plan your PowerPoint slide show***

Use the PowerPoint planning sheet on the following pages to:

- ☐ decide which camp experiences you will use
- ☐ draft the written text for each slide
- ☐ decide which photographs, pictures and formatting you will use on each slide.

### ***Create your PowerPoint slide show***

Make each PowerPoint slide using the information from your planning sheet. Your teacher will provide access to a computer with the PowerPoint software.

#### **Remember:**

- You will also be speaking in Italian about your camp experiences when you present your PowerPoint slide show.
- Make sure your slide show will have enough information (using at least six slides) so that you can talk for 3 minutes when you present it to the class.

- ☐ write the spoken text to accompany each slide.


2. Practise your spoken text. Think about:

- ☐ rhythm (pause and flow).


3. Present your PowerPoint slide show to the class.


