## Children with disability: Information

This resource provides information for teachers on categories of disability identified by the Department of Education, Training and Employment (DETE).

Educators must offer a person with disability the same educational opportunities as everyone else (Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations 2005, *Disability Standards for Education*, [www.deewr.gov.au/Schooling/Programs/Pages/disabilitystandardsforeducation.aspx](http://www.deewr.gov.au/Schooling/Programs/Pages/disabilitystandardsforeducation.aspx)).

Allow approximately 30 minutes to view and reflect on the information provided.

These resources support teachers to meet Standards 2 and 4 of the *Australian professional standards for teachers*.

## Disability categories

There are six categories of disability identified by DETE:

- Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- hearing impairment (HI)
- intellectual impairment (II)
- physical impairment (PI)
- speech–language impairment (SLI)
- vision impairment (VI).
