Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Languages — Resource guide



Several Indigenous Language Centres and community organisations in Queensland support the revival and maintenance of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander languages. Activities may include language research, exhibitions and community training as well as the recording and/or documentation of Indigenous languages in Queensland. Other groups, such as Aboriginal Land Councils, cultural organisations and Elders' groups, may also be undertaking activities involving languages.

Schools are encouraged to seek out language centres and other community groups in their locality and region with whom to explore partnerships that can support the revival and teaching and learning of languages in their communities.

The geographic areas covered by language centres are generally based on the former ATSIC (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission) regions, as this is the basis for funding assistance from the Commonwealth Government.
