Purpose of the product

This technique assesses the application of a range of creative, expressive, cognitive, technical and physical skills in the production of media artwork/s. It is the outcome of applying these skills as students demonstrate knowledge and understanding of media technologies, media communications and media in society, and concepts and ideas related to the electives and appropriate to the intended context, purpose and audience.

Create a business card for a digital artist that promotes their identity as a media artist.

- identify, research and interpret information about a current digital artist of your choice to develop an understanding of their personal aesthetic, including
 - the contexts and purposes of their work
 - their application of elements and principles of design
 - their preferred techniques and technologies
- create a business card that promotes the digital artist to prospective clients by conveying their identity as an artist, ensuring you
 - organise and apply graphic design elements and principles and processes to design the business card
 - demonstrate practical skills, techniques and technologies in graphic design to design and produce the business card.
