Suggestions to support learning from home

The assessment technique will state the assessable component/s. A project will have at least two components. Examples of components are:

- practical component (used in Project) use a visual or graph to represent the processes and procedures evident in the business, such as
 - financial forecasts such as budgets and report from computerised accounting packages
 - financial documents such as an online banking documentation, banking statements
 - graphics such as business logos, layout of a store, letterhead or flow charts
- written component (used in Project, Extended response) create a written response supported by references or, where appropriate, data, tables, flow charts, diagrams or graphics to communicate ideas and information
- spoken component (used in Project, Extended response) create a spoken response to be presented either live or virtually
- multimodal component (used in Project) use two modes delivered at the same time to communicate ideas and information to a live audience or virtually. Modes could include written, spoken/signed, nonverbal.
