Analyse the stimulus materials in your assessment task to identify relevant arguments, ideas and information. Deconstruct and evaluate relevant arguments for validity, soundness or cogency. Construct a response in support of a clearly drawn conclusion/thesis through reasoned justification and refutation of counterarguments. Reflect on and refine the quality of thinking demonstrated in the response, e.g. using the values of inquiry framework (Australian Curriculum Studies Association, www.acsa.edu.au/pages/images/VOI%20A3%20colour.pdf). Read and unpack the annotated IA2 sample response on the Philosophy & Reason subject page. Review the Internal assessment section of the subject report that can be found on the Teaching tab on the Philosophy & Reason subject page. Focus on the effective practices samples.
