Investigate the issue by conducting research using the inquiry process.

Analyse the issue from the selected religious perspective.

Write an analytical essay.

Resources Access to sacred texts and authoritative sources, library and online sources

Context

You have been studying how religious adherents address personal ethical issues in a situation or situations that require them to consider the implications of a moral decision in relation to their faith tradition. As a class, you have explored the various ways that adherents in Christian traditions explore personal issues in a contemporary society. You have explored various perspectives and approaches when addressing problems and identifying alternatives when faced with making a significant personal ethical decision.

Task

Select one contemporary ethical issue from the list below and identify a specific aspect as the focus for your inquiry.

Investigate the influence of religious ethics on a Christian adherent concerning a response to the selected contemporary ethical issue. Explain features and expressions of Christianity and the ways they inform and influence a response to the contemporary personal ethical issue selected.

Analyse perspectives of religious expression, incorporating relevant information from religious texts and other authoritative sources, to explain Christianity's influence when responding to a contemporary personal ethical issue. Evaluate the significance and influence of Christianity on religious—ethical stances made by adherents when responding to the chosen issue.

Create an analytical essay to present your findings. Ensure you acknowledge all sources using a recognised reference system.

The contemporary ethical issue is to be selected from the following:

- beginning and end of life, e.g. reproductive technologies, palliative care
- pivotal life events or situations, e.g. arranged marriages, having/raising/disciplining children, contentious objection in medicine/military service
- body image, e.g. cosmetic enhancement, tattooing
- interpersonal conflict, e.g. domestic violence, misuse of social media or messaging
- medical technologies, e.g. organ farming, genetic engineering, xenotransplantation
- substance abuse, e.g. steroids in sport.

Checkpoints

(After approximately 3 hours of 15): Planning check, hypothesis devised
(After approximately 6 hours of 15): Progress check, hypothesis, information gathering and research underway
(After approximately 9 hours of 15): Progress check, hypothesis, information gathering and research progress, referencing details, drafting
(After approximately 12 hours of 15): Draft due
(After approximately 15 hours of 15): Final submission
