Assessment type	Suggestions to support learning from home
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Project</b></li><li>• <b>Investigation</b></li></ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Consult with your teacher to determine how you will demonstrate any practical aspects of the task.</li><li>• Keep a logbook to demonstrate development and progress of your project or investigation.</li><li>• Consult with your teacher to determine a method that allows you to collect primary data remotely.</li><li>• Use online resources to gather secondary information relevant to your research question, such as Wikipedia list of open access journals <a href="https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/List_of_open-access_journals">https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/List_of_open-access_journals</a> for Science subjects.</li><li>• Consider strategies to modify your research question to suit the data that you may be required to collect remotely.</li></ul>
