

# EA marker training schedule

## Script selection and subject-specific training

External assessment subject marking operations, including script selection and subject-specific training dates, are determined by the 2024 external assessment timetable, the number of student responses and the estimated time needed to mark a student response.

Each subject's marking operation continues until all marking is completed for that subject. Chief markers and lead markers complete script selection for up to two days; following this, markers attend subject-specific marker training sessions online for up to three days.

## Online access

Chief markers, lead markers and markers will all access the remote online sessions:

- from an appropriate location, such as their home office
- using the link provided in the EA Markers application (app) in the QCAA Portal.

Sessions cannot be accessed until the scheduled script selection or training day/s for each subject.

## Hours of work

Chief markers, lead markers and markers are all required to attend scheduled training days for the entirety of each day. The start and finish times indicated above should reflect your actual start and finish times, and be included in your timesheet.

## Travel

Chief markers are entitled to a travel allowance from the QCAA if they:

- are participating in script selection and training in person, and
- live more than 80 km from the venue (one way).
