Purpose

Background

To maintain the credibility and integrity of Senior Statements, the QSA requires all schools with Years 11 and 12 students enrolled in Authority and Authority-registered subjects to have approved work programs and study plans.

Information

Students studying the subjects on the attached list will be issued with the Queensland Certificate of Education and Senior Statement in 2010. To maintain the integrity of the Queensland Certificate of Education, it is essential that this office's database on work program approval is accurate. Your response to this memorandum will help us achieve the highest possible accuracy.

The approval advice relates to work programs and study plans for subjects studied by Year 11 cohorts in 2009. The printout provides information on senior Authority and Authority-registered subjects — there is no reference to other subjects that may be recorded on certificates, for example TAFE or AMEB subjects. The work programs were due to be submitted by the end of Term 1, 2009.
