IPT and ITS curriculum consultation forums

Purpose

To invite Information Processing and Technology (IPT) and Information Technology Systems (ITS) teachers to participate in consultation forums. These face-to-face forums and webinars are to gather information to inform the redevelopment of senior syllabuses.

Background

To support the introduction of a new senior assessment and tertiary entrance system for students entering Year 11 in 2018, the QCAA will commence the redevelopment of existing syllabus documents this year.

When considering the development, maintenance and revision of senior syllabus, the QCAA considers a range of criteria to guide decision making. These criteria are set out in the QCAA policy document *Developing, maintaining and revising senior syllabuses: criteria for decision making.*

Information

Forums will be convened in March and April 2016. Of the nine forums planned, eight will be face-to-face and one will be a webinar to connect with IPT and ITS teachers in remote Queensland or those who may be unable to attend the face-to-face forums.

The forums will focus on:

- gathering feedback on the application of criteria to Information Processing and Technology (2010) and Information Technology Systems (2012)
- presenting and seeking feedback on:
 - evidence and data for both Information Processing and Technology (2010) and Information Technology Systems (2012)
 - ideas about how to redevelop the senior Technologies curriculum.
