2017 QCS Test markers — reapplicants and new markers

Purpose

To invite teachers to apply to mark student responses to the Writing Task (WT) or Short Response (SR) subtests of the 2017 Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test.

Background

The 2017 QCS Test marking operation will be held in Brisbane from Saturday 16 September to Friday 22 September.

The primary objective of the marking operation is to grade student responses validly and reliably according to a prepared marking guide (for the WT) or item-specific marking schemes (for the SR).

Markers gain valuable professional experience that assists them in preparing students for the test. They are paid as casual employees for their marking and training. Marker training contributes to continuing professional development (CPD) points for registration renewal.

Each year, the QCAA recruits markers to add to the existing pool of QCS Test markers.

To be eligible to mark the QCS Test, new applicants must attend a recruitment session and successfully complete the recruitment requirements.

The QCAA will continue its commitment to employing markers from around the state.

New marker applicants

New applicants must:

- be a registered (or previously registered) teacher
- demonstrate an understanding of assessment using criteria and standards
- be able to apply a prescriptive marking model
- demonstrate an ability to follow instructions
- teach or live in Queensland.
