2017 Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test: Number of Year 12 students sitting the test

Purpose

To ask chief supervisors to inform the QCAA of the number of Year 12 students intending to sit the QCS Test in 2017.

Background

The QCAA conducts the QCS Test in Queensland secondary schools each year. Every student has a right to sit the QCS Test in the year they exit Year 12. All students who are eligible for an Overall Position (OP) **must** sit the test unless they have been granted exemption. Students who are OP-ineligible **may choose** to sit the test.

The quantity of test materials sent to each test centre is based on the total number of Year 12 students (OP-eligible and OP-ineligible) sitting the test, as indicated by the chief supervisor. Therefore, the QCAA seeks a realistic estimate of the number of students sitting the test.

Information

A student's individual QCS Test result does not determine their OP. Subject Achievement Indicators (SAIs) are used to calculate a student's OP. This means that a student achieves their best OP by doing as well as they can in each of their subjects. QCS Test data from OP-eligible students is used for scaling purposes only.

OP-ineligible students may choose to sit the test. While being OP-ineligible does not exclude the possibility of a student going to university, it does limit the courses they can apply for in Queensland and interstate. However, a student who achieves a grade of C or higher in the QCS Test will meet the minimum literacy and numeracy requirements to be eligible for a Queensland Certificate of Education.

What you need to do

- 1. Discuss the requirement to sit the QCS Test with OP-eligible Year 12 students and the advantages of sitting the test with OP-ineligible Year 12 students.
- 2. Update the QCS Test Administration database with the total number of students sitting the test by **Friday 14 April 2017**: www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/senior/qcs-test/administration/ database.
- 3. Inform the QCAA if any students from your school will be sitting the test at a different test centre by **Friday 19 May**. Complete the *Students sitting at an alternative test centre* form: www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/senior/qcs-test/administration.
