Delivery of LUI cards and online resources for students and parents

Purpose

To advise schools about the:

- delivery of Learner Unique Identifier (LUI) cards for Year 10 students
- online resources for students and parents available on the QCAA website.

Background

QCAA is committed to working with schools to:

- encourage students to log in to their learning account regularly to check their personal and enrolment details, and become familiar with the log in process before results are released at the end of Year 12
- raise students' and parents' awareness and understanding of
 - the key aspects of Queensland's current system of senior assessment and tertiary entrance
 - the revitalisation of the existing systems.

LUI card delivery

LUI cards for Year 10 students will start arriving in schools next week. These contain a credit card sized 'pop out' card for students to record their LUI and password. Students need these details each time they access their learning account on the Student Connect website:
