Syllabus implementation workshops — an overview for school leaders

Purpose

To advise school leaders about the availability of a new resource on the information being delivered at senior syllabus implementation workshops.

Information

Subject-specific workshops are currently being delivered to Year 11 and 12 teachers who will be implementing new syllabuses from 2019. Around 17,000 teachers will attend these workshops over the next twelve months.

Workshops cover unit planning, teaching and learning, and assessment. Participants map a sequence of learning and assessment using the syllabus and support materials, and discuss the syllabus construct.
