# 2018 QCS Test: Number of Year 12 students sitting the test

#### **Purpose**

To ask chief supervisors to inform the QCAA of the number of Year 12 students intending to sit the Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test in 2018.

#### Background

The QCAA conducts the QCS Test in Queensland secondary schools each year. Every student has a right to sit the QCS Test in the year they exit Year 12. All students who are eligible for an Overall Position (OP) **must** sit the test unless they have been granted exemption. Students who are OP-ineligible **may choose** to sit the test.

The quantity of test materials sent to each test centre is based on the total number of Year 12 students (OP-eligible and OP-ineligible) sitting the test, as indicated by the chief supervisor.

Therefore, the QCAA seeks a realistic estimate of the number of students intending to sit the test.

#### Information

A student's individual QCS Test result does not determine their OP. Subject Achievement Indicators (SAIs) are used to calculate a student's OP. This means that a student achieves their best OP by doing as well as they can in each of their subjects. QCS Test data from OP-eligible students is used for scaling purposes only.

OP-ineligible students may choose to sit the test. While being OP-ineligible does not exclude the possibility of a student going to university, it does limit the courses they can apply for in Queensland and interstate. However, a student who achieves a grade of C or higher in the QCS Test will meet the minimum literacy and numeracy requirements to be eligible for a Queensland Certificate of Education.

## What you need to do

- 1. Discuss the requirement to sit the QCS Test with OP-eligible Year 12 students and the advantages of sitting the test with OP-ineligible Year 12 students.
- Update the QCS Test Administration database by Friday 20 April with the total number of students intending to sit the test: www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/senior/qcstest/administration/database.
- 3. Inform the QCAA by **Friday 18 May** if any students from your school will be sitting the test at a different test centre. Complete the form *Students sitting at an alternative test centre*, available at www.qcaa.qld.edu.au/senior/qcs-test/administration/database.
